Declaration pursuant to Section 87 Para. 2 Austrian Stock Corporation Act (AktG)

- 2. I have not been legally convicted of any criminal offence punishable by a court of law, especially an offence that would cast doubt on my professional integrity pursuant to Section 87 Para. 2 (3) AktG.
